SATURDAY 18th OCTOBER: BUTLERS IN COLONIAL SYDNEY 9:00am - 5:00pm

The morning will open with a talk on **William Butler**, a convict on the First Fleet, who was the first person to bring the Butler surname to Australia. We shall also hear about **Lawrence Butler** a talented cabinet maker, **James Butler** who was John and Elizabeth Macarthur's butler, and **Charles Ormond Butler** who smuggled opium into Sydney.

SUNDAY 19th OCTOBER: OTHER BUTLERS IN THE NETWORK 9:00am – 5:00pm

The focus this day will be on hearing about Butlers from other parts of our Southern Cross network, including **New Zealand** and **Argentina**. And there will be a presentation on the life and activities of the first **Chief Butler of Ireland**, whose descendants became the Earls and Dukes of Ormond, and who were based at Kilkenny Castle in Ireland from 1391 to 1967. This fascinating information has been discovered by a member researching numerous original medieval records and the story is not available in the public domain.

MONDAY 20th OCTOBER: VISITS TO HISTORIC SITES 9:00am - 5:30pm

We first visit the **Old Government House** in Parramatta, to learn about the history of this building and view items of furniture made by Lawrence Butler. We shall then travel to the **Lancers Memorial Museum**, mainland Australia's oldest military barracks. Lunch will be served in the Church Hall at **St Patrick's Cathedral** and we shall hear about more Butlers who lived in the area in Colonial times. We then travel to **Elizabeth Farm**, the original home of Elizabeth & John Macarthur, and where their butler, James Butler worked.
